This can of worms opened up as a result of my inquiry into the antics of Pastor Glen Cole, the Superintendent of the Assemblies of God of the Northern California District. Apparently, I had invaded a spiritual territory that only a John Torell can handle successfully. Did not John Torell, in his <u>The Dove</u>, Summer 1995, run down Carl Sanders? This Carl Sanders was in issue after issue. Was I invading the sacred grounds of Sacramento in which only John Torell had jurisdiction?

John Torell is a victim of our Pentecostal environment

Now, I love John Torell. He is a victim of the environment called Pentecostalism. It is a disease. I lived in his shoes for 20 years as a Pentecostal and never knew I was saved by grace. Nobody told me so; the temple loves the law. There is nothing in the four gospels that can cure you of this error, for Apostle Paul calls Jesus "a minister of the circumcision." (Rom. 15:8) Jesus died for all, but His message was to His own. "I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel." (Matt. 15:24) This is what Jesus told the woman of Canaan, a Gentile, who came crying, "Lord help me." Jesus answered her, "It is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast it to dogs (Gentiles)." (Matt. 15:26)

Gentiles do not get it through their thick skulls of tradition. The four gospels is still the Jewish table. We don't eat at this table! You keep eating at the wrong table and you'll become a "Jew" that "resteth in the law." (Rom. 2:17) Even in Revelation 3:9, the Gentile Philadelphia church had those "which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie." Who are these Jews? Gentiles who never learned to eat from the proper table.

Oral Roberts, a Spiritual Jew?

Oral Roberts is such a "Jew." "I read the four gospels over a hundred times, and I've concluded it is all the gospel a person needs." "For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned." (Matt. 12:37)

If you want a healthy meal, especially for a new convert, sit him down to a meat and potato meal of Romans, have a fresh vegetable of Galatians, a salad from Ephesians, and hot Corinthian biscuits. This is exactly how Jimmy Swaggart, a convert to Assembly of God doctrine on marriage being a covenant, got his tit in a wringer by ousting Marvin Gorman, his competition in Baton Rouge. Of course, this was back in the days when the Assemblies of God had successfully corralled the Holy Ghost

into their box. Swaggart appointed himself as a captain to protect the holiness of the box by getting Marvin Gorman dropped from the rostrum of the Assemblies of God.

Rev. Woodrow, you were never connected with the Assemblies of God. You're my kind of man. I love you dearly, Ralph Woodrow! You're not guilty as charged. The case is dismissed.

If Jimmy Swaggart had never joined the Assemblies of God, he would have been less likely to have swallowed the mixture of law and grace. It is this false doctrine about holiness that brought about his fall. Anytime you attempt to be "perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect" (Matt. 5:48), God will humble your pride. You are a mortal and He is immortal. If you can't figure that out, you are about to experience how fragile a human really is.

I love Jimmy Swaggart. I still enjoy hearing him preach. In our humanistic culture, the person is never to blame. It is the environment. I'm persuaded that in Jimmy Swaggart's case, it was the environment. He came to believe the Assembly of God doctrine on holiness, which is none other than an outward form of piety. Holiness unto the Lord is described in Romans 4 as "imputed righteousness" (Rom. 4:22) through being able to believe into existence the things that God hath said. Then, it is credited, or accounted, to us as righteousness. This is not the environment that Jimmy Swaggart was reared in.

In the Captain's court the Assemblies of God would be found liable

In my court, the Assemblies of God would be liable. Jimmy Swaggart could come into my court and sue the Assemblies of God for damages because they taught "for doctrines the commandments of men" (Matt. 15:9), and not from Holy Writ.

The Assemblies of God are a type of Pilate washing his hands. Pilate was only trying to enforce the rules of Rome, just as John Torell is attempting to enforce the identical same rules that the Assemblies of God has decreed. If you're Pentecostal, whether in or out of the cage, they all agree marriage is a covenant. It all goes with the territory.

Moses' Law more liberal than the Assemblies of God on Marriage

Even under the law of Moses, they had two sets of rules for marriage. One for the priests, and one for the laity. Priests were forbidden to marry anyone that was not a virgin. (Lev. 21:10-15) The laity was free to marry divorcees. (Deu. 24:1-4) Why does the priesthood of the Assemblies of God only have one set of rules regarding marriage? The law of Moses had more leniency and grace than is found in the Assemblies of God. Their attitude is "one size fits all."

Why are there only rules on divorce and none on marriage? If a woman has had five abortions, does she qualify for marriage to an Assembly of God minister? Should a woman marrying an Assembly of God preacher be required to disclose her previous sex life before entering into a "'til death pact" agreement called a covenant? Without a full disclosure in today's society, how can an Assembly of God preacher know whether or not he is marrying a five time mass murderer? If you can't make it with her, you've chosen the wrong profession.

Where do you think today's women go looking for a husband when they outgrow the streets? They are coming! Men that have been playing with bar flies, suddenly wake up and say, I need a wife. Where is he going to look for one? The gays are coming! Are you ready to handle the traffic?

This would be the conclusion of the matter if it were held in my court.

John Torell and Christmas

In John Torell's court there is still this matter of Christmas. Now, you must plead guilty to these charges because John Torell was your number one adherent after reading your book, <u>Babylon, Mystery Religion</u>. Mr. Ralph Woodrow, would you please tell this court, did you write a book on Christmas being a pagan day and all who honor this day are idolaters? O Israel, thy prophets are like the foxes in the deserts. Ye have not gone up into the gaps, neither made up the hedge for the house of Israel to stand in the battle in the day of the LORD. They have seen vanity and lying divination, saying, The LORD saith: and the LORD hath not sent them: and they have made others to hope that they would confirm the word... Therefore thus saith the Lord

GOD; Because ye have spoken vanity (positive thinking), and seen lies, therefore, behold, I am against you, saith the Lord GOD." (Ezk. 13:1-8)

I've already prophesied against Dallas Theological Seminary (DTS). This citadel in Dallas, Texas is the bastion for most of our theological beliefs which John Darby and C.I. Scofield created. It is what you are to believe as a Christian because John Darby says, "This is the faith."

The pulpit is much like our news media

In Jesus' day, He called it "the tradition of the elders." (Mk. 7:5) "Full well ye reject the commandment of God, that ye may keep the your own tradition (the traditions of the elders)." (Mk. 7:9) What are these "traditions" in the 21st century church? Traditions are things we believe simply because we relied on the pulpit to tell us the truth. The pulpit today is much like our news media. If you had believed every word of a Dan Rather report, John Kerry would be our President. His famous "October surprise" backfired and revealed his big teeth as a left wing wolf ready to devour the sheep's little vote for George Bush. The sheep have learned to listen to Paul Harvey and Rush Limbaugh. The left despises talk radio. They believe freedom of speech should be legal only for the left. If Kerry had won, the left would shut Rushbo up!

The Captain prophesies against the house that Darby-Scofield built

In introducing the most prophetic chapter of the four gospels, Matthew 24, Jesus was unimpressed by what the disciples all looked upon with admiration. "And his disciples came to him for to shew him the buildings of the temple." The disciples were all caught up in the concrete and the huge stones to build such a temple. Jesus said unto his disciples, "See ye not all these things (pointing to the huge buildings that surrounded the temple)? verily I say unto you, There shall not be left here one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down." (Matt. 24:1-2)

If you've ever walked on campus of Oral Roberts University in Tulsa, OK, you'd be impressed, as were the disciples at the enormity of the buildings. I have never seen DTS, but I'm sure it is of equal grandeur. "For that which is highly esteemed among men is abomination in the sight of God." (Lk. 16:15)

As I was reading Matthew 24, all of a sudden it dawned on me, if you would "say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove." (Matt. 17:20) "There shall not be left here one stone (of their doctrine) upon another (lie), that shall not be thrown down." (Matt. 24:2) Jesus first prophesied the doom of the temple before expounding on prophecy.

Christianity Today and the Christian Research Institute (CRI), are a couple of the self-appointed watchdogs that will protect every stone put into this building that Darby-Scofieldism has built. But you are really powerless to speak unto this mountain while (like the disciples) you are caught up in the mutual admiration society admiring concrete. All Bible colleges are built upon the premise that Darbyism is a sure foundation.

I never heard the name John Darby until I entered a Pentecostal Bible college. In a Bible college, seeing how they revere John Darby, you think surely he must be one of the twelve. This is regardless of denomination. The seed was sown by The First Scofield Study Bible, 1909 (KJV).

Just as much a sin to believe a lie, as to tell one

It is just as much a sin to believe a lie, as it is to tell one. "They received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. And for this cause (for believing a lie) God shall send them strong delusion (Gk.-straying from orthodoxy – Strong's 4106), that they should believe a lie (to believe a lie is as sinful as telling one): that they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness." (2 Thess. 2:10-12)

In this scripture please note, if you insist on believing a lie, God will make it even more difficult to return to orthodoxy. God shall send a strong delusion! Could that delusion that God will send be sitting in the living room of every man's house, called Christian television?

Christian TV fills a vacuum in the hearts of the wannabees

Television's success is based on ratings, their broad appeal and the money it can conjure up. Strangely, the doctrines being taught over Christian television are purported to be as biblical because they fill this vacuum of the wannabees. The prosperity gospel feeds the gastric juices of the "I wanna be rich" crowd.

#1 – "Seed faith" giving, invented by Oral Roberts, the father of the modern day prosperity gospel. "Give to get," exactly the doctrine of the slot machines in Vegas.

#2 – "Pre-trib" rapture doctrine.

#3 – "Eternal security."

#4 – "Marriage is a covenant."

Christian television, masquerading under the "pre-trib" doctrine, will be the Judas goat to lead the church into the arms of the New Age (or the falling away). Without oil, you cannot "endure to the end" (Matt. 24:13)—only the "wise" survive. No one is left behind. They were absorbed into the New Age religion during the "falling away" (2 Thess. 2:3).

Pre-trib doctrine will be abandoned when Catholics abandon Purgatory

Do you know why the preachers love this pre-trib doctrine? For the same reason Catholicism loves the doctrine of Purgatory. Money! Just follow the money! The Catholic Church was going bankrupt, the coffers were empty, until the Pope came up with this gimmick of Purgatory. The doctrine stems from a scripture in the Apocrypha.

I used to have a weekly Bible study with a Catholic priest. He was curious about my faith, and I had questions for him. He had to first obtain permission from a priest of a higher order to continue the Bible study. "Does it appear that you can convert him?" The priest said, "Yes." Had he given the truth, that he couldn't convert me, that would have ended the study. We both enjoyed this comparison of religions.

If and whenever Catholicism abandons Purgatory, only then will evangelical fundamentalist Christians stop teaching this "pre-trib" rapture doctrine.

Only one scripture the pre-tribbers have—Rev. 4:1

The only scripture pre-tribbers relate to in support of their position is Revelation 4:1, where God raptured the Apostle John. "Come up hither, and I will shew these things which must be hereafter." While on the Isle of Patmos, John was given a vision. "I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet, saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, WHAT THOU SEEST, write in a book." (Rev. 1:10-11) We know John was obedient because everyone that owns a Bible has the Book of Revelation that John wrote. We know the purpose of why John was raptured; to "write a book," being careful to record everything he saw.

John found the Church in heaven

In spite of the fabrications invented by the pre-trib theologians, John found no evidence of the church until after the opening of the sixth seal and "a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands." (Rev. 7:9)

"And one of the elders answered, saying unto me (John), What are these which are arrayed in white robes? and whence came they?" (Rev. 7:13) This elder talking to John had evidently thought he knew everything about heaven until he ran into this great multitude!

Scofield invents a 3rd resurrection

Do you know what C.I. Scofield does to cover up who this great multitude is? He creates still ANOTHER rapture by his headliner for chapter 7 – (Parenthetical: the saved of the tribulation period). Pre-tribber's doctrine has to create raptures that do not exist in scripture. One lie always leads you directly to another one. That parenthetical statement alone, in defining the great multitude by C.I. Scofield, is "adding" to the word of God. "*If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book.*" (Rev. 22:18) The entire "Church of the First Born" should stand up as a voice denouncing the heresy taught at DTS as gospel.

"Left Behind" sells 47 million

Tim LaHaye recently sold 47 million copies of his <u>Left Behind</u> series. If he only makes one dollar off of every copy sold, he is a multi-millionaire spreading a lie. Do you hear me? No one is going to be "left behind." "For without are dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and maketh a lie." (Rev. 22:15)

The sale of 47 million copies of a book by a fundamentalist preacher even made the Fox News with Tim LaHaye as a guest of Bill O'Reilly. Ever since 9-11, a wakeup call is being evidenced in the church. There is a tremendous void that cries for understanding of what lies in the future. This is the church's greatest hour to teach what the Bible says, and not "your traditions." "Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition." (Mk. 7:13) That one verse of scripture convicted me because that was not

my ambition, to make God's Word of none effect! Tim LaHaye is tapping into a suddenly awakened America, but no one will be "left behind."

"No one will be left behind!" (the Captain)

This is the reason for the Great Commission, "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations." (Matt. 28:19) They simply do not know, including America. We've been brainwashed by the washed out theology of John Darby. <u>Left Behind</u> is all a part of that traditional school of theology.

<u>Left Behind</u> will cause you to become one of the five foolish virgins which "took their lamps (type of the Word of God), and took no oil with them." (Matt. 25:3) "Thy word is a lamp unto my feet." (Ps. 119:105) So, you are a virgin, unspotted from the world, religious and reading your Bible. This is as far as Darbyism can carry you, but "only believism" is a lie. Even the demons believe, and tremble. (Jas. 2:19) there is always something you must "do" to confirm your faith.

Pentecostalism owns the Electronic Church

My take on this parable is that all 47 million became nominal Christians as a result of reading <u>Left Behind</u>, but 50% of these tuned onto Christian television where they heard about the "oil" from the TBN-Daystar televangelists. The Electronic Church has taken over the church. If you view Christian television regularly, three times a week, you are a member of the Electronic Church. Pentecostalism owns the Electronic Church. We sell the oil.

"Ten virgins, which took their lamps (Bibles), and went forth to meet the bridegroom ... While the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept." (Matt. 25:1,5) What caused the entire church to fall asleep and to slumber (go into deeper sleep)? The doctrine of the pre-trib rapture has affected the entire church. They believed Jesus was coming soon, like tomorrow, after hearing a John Hagee sermon, "He could arrive at any moment."

"At midnight there was a cry made"

"And at midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh; go ye out to meet him."

(Matt. 25:6) What was the cry that suddenly caused the church to wake up? I believe the cry that woke up the church was the fall of the Twin Towers in New York City. That cry ever rings in my ears! It is the cry that toppled the god of materialism that rested in the minds of all Americans. Suddenly, we came to the realization we need God more than the almighty dollar. Proof of this was evidenced in the recent election where voters didn't vote their pocketbooks, but voted on morality issues. This has never occurred in the history of politics as far as I can remember. Do you see the number of red states that voted Republican?

Ever since 9-11, the church has suddenly woken up. Tim LaHaye, and his 47 million copies sold, is the hard evidence someone is coming out of a deep slumber. It would have been an impossibility to even think about before 9-11.

"And the foolish said unto the wise, Give us of your oil; for our lamps are gone out. But the wise answered, saying, Not so; lest there be not enough for us and you: but go (as we did) ye rather to them

that SELL, AND BUY (TBN, Daystar, television evangelists) for yourselves." (Matt. 25:8-9) Pentecostalism owns Christian television, and of necessity to evangelize the world, must SELL, and you BUY their wares to perpetuate this gospel.

Ralph Woodrow question

Now, for your question Ralph Woodrow, "I don't know what you mean about me selling and buying after the rapture." There is a certain amount of presumption and consensus to public opinion because all the knowledge I have concerning you as a person was obtained through John Torell and his nephew, Charles Thorell. I love being wrong, believe me. It is boring to be always right. I presume you seek acceptance in the widest audience your books will bring? The best route to follow is that of Tim LaHaye.

I guess you've come to understand Tim LaHaye is not one of my heroes of the faith, but he is a very successful businessman, making a lot of money by simply following the party line.

Do you consider yourself to be a "party liner," adhering to the guideposts as laid down by John Darby? Only you can answer that question. Often Bible bookstores accept only party line books.

"The Sign" prophesied against a stone of DTS

For example, <u>The Sign</u>, written by Robert Van Kampen, is one of the great books challenging the party line relative to the pre-trib doctrine. Van Kampen was a graduate of Wheaton Seminary. He was one of them! But God's Word is the truth, and every man a liar. (Rom. 3:4)

"New Age Bible Versions" prophesied against another stone

Another example is <u>New Age Bible Versions</u>, authored by G.A. Riplinger. This woman did her homework! This sort of book is not sitting out in the front row as a best seller!

Ralph Woodrow challenged
