Captain's Answer #1

This email was sent to me during the festivities of Hanukkah, Christmas and New Year's Day. The Captain wants all hands back on deck. Shore leave is over! We must launch out into the deep waters where the big fish swim. Marlins don't swim in your little river near your house. Time is of the essence as we enter 2006. We've made it thus far, *"For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences (AIDS, bird flu), and earthquakes, in divers places. All these are THE BEGINNING OF SORROWS."* (Matt. 24:7-8) In the meantime, believers are being deceived. (Matt. 24:11-13)
