Is John Roberts a type of an end time John the Baptist calling for all politicians to repent, and indirectly, the ministers of Jesus, as well?

John Roberts, President Bush's choice to be the next Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, through his brilliant exhibition of answering questions of Senators for 22 hours (the longest grueling for confirmation in our history) to obtain their confirmation vote, actually turned tables on these wise Senators who soon became his students. In this classroom, Roberts taught these 18 Senators of the Judicial

Committee (10 Republicans and 8 Democrats), and the nation, what the term "rule of law" really means.

Senators go to John Roberts' classroom to learn the "rule of law

Most Senators today, represent some special interest group such as the environmentalists, corporate America, the Black Caucus, women's rights, rights of minorities, gay rights, children's rights, Planned Parenthood, the far right, the hard left, and others simply "pork" for their own state. These leftists Senators like Dianne Feinstein, Patrick Leahy, Charles Schumer, Ted Kennedy and Russell Feingold, were in shock because this young man could be the Chief Justice for the next forty years. They had never confronted a "rule of law" lawyer. "If a rich man comes before my court, and his case falls within the boundaries of the rule of law, I will take his side. If a poor man comes likewise, and his case falls

Even though he should decide cases strictly on their facts and the law, I think it's helpful for a potential chief justice to hear from the people and their elected representatives directly before he joins the Supreme Court.

Some senators, for example, complained about activist judges making law in their decisions. Roberts observed that the only real limitation on judges is their own self-restraint. He does not strike me as one who needs to be reminded of the need for self-restraint, but maybe some of his future colleagues were tuned in to the proceedings and heard the message.

Second, Roberts is, as we've seen over the past 20 hours, <u>A GREAT TEACHER</u>.

His explanations of the law have been clear and concise. And it doesn't' t hurt any of us to become reacquainted with legal principles and cases that we may have forgotten. I found his discussion interesting and helpful, for example, in understanding his concept of judicial modesty.

How different from the questions first asked when John the Baptist began his ministry. John said he was, "The voice of one crying in the wilderness...Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance," quickly addressing the Closed Door theology, "And think not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to our father," or "We be

Abraham's seed." (Matt. 3:3,8-9, Jn. 8:33) These Jews believed they were unconditionally saved, simply by birth, being born of the seed of Abraham.

Who art thou? John the Baptist

Then, "the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, Who art thou? And he confessed, and denied not; but confessed, I am not the Christ. And they asked him, What then? Art thou Elias? And he saith, I am not. Art thou that prophet? And he answered, No." (Jn. 1:19-21)

Who art thou? John Roberts

The grilling of Judge Roberts by 18 Senators is somewhat similar to the questions presented to John the Baptist. "Who art thou? that we may give an answer to them that sent us. What sayest thou of thyself?" (Jn. 1:22) Dianne Feinstein said, "We want to know your stand on abortion, women's rights, rights of minorities, so we can report to the special interests that financially support us. Who do you represent, the rich or the poor?" Judging purely by the rule of law, Dianne Feinstein found out that there is no discrimination for either the rich or the poor in John Roberts' court of law; both are treated equally. He is impartial, and no respecter of persons as far as class status.

I was absolutely stunned by the intellect and humility (a rare combination, I can assure you) of John Roberts. He was teaching the entire Congress and the nation by example what a judge, guided solely by the "rule of law" was supposed to be. If ever the Supreme Court needed a definition of what a judge ought to be like, Judge John Roberts successfully got that message across to a worldwide audience over television.

But, I detected something even more incredible. Unknowingly, in the Providence of God, Judge Roberts was speaking to me and every man on how to guide his own life as a Christian by a "cloud" that I'll term, "the rule of truth."

Daniel followed a cloud in a night vision

But God! God still rules in the affairs of men. Daniel, in the process of giving the interpretation of a dream to Nebuchudnezzar, king of Babylon, first blessed the God of heaven Who gave him a night vision that revealed the interpretation.

"Blessed be the name of God for ever and ever: for wisdom and might are his: and he changeth the times and the seasons: he removeth kings, and setteth up kings: he giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding: he revealeth the deep and secret things (like the king's dream): he knoweth what is in the darkness, and the light dwelleth with him. (Why would anyone go to a fortuneteller?)

I thank thee, and praise thee, O thou God of my fathers, WHO HAST GIVEN ME WISDOM and might, and HAST MADE KNOWN UNTO ME now what we desired (inquired) of thee: for THOU HAST NOW MADE KNOWN unto us the king's matter." (Dan. 2:20-23)

Israel always erred because, "they have not known MY WAYS"

God derided the children of Israel, "When your fathers tempted me, proved me, and saw my works forty years. Wherefore I was grieved with that generation, and said, They do alway err in their heart; and they have not known my ways." (Heb. 3:9-10)

What are God's ways? To correctly answer that question, God warns us that we are only pilgrims on a pilgrimage through this life. "For here have we no continuing city, but we seek one to come." (Heb. 13:14) No one ever caught the vision more plainly than John Bunyan when he wrote his immortal classic in a New Bedford jail, <u>The Pilgrim's Progress</u>.

Supposing Pilgrim had built a castle alongside the highway to the Celestial City? Suppose he decided to put down roots and become a Baptist, a Methodist or a Pentecostal? This is why the scripture tells us, "But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved." (Matt. 24:13) In another portion of scripture it is described as "running a race." "Know ye not that they which run in a race run all, but one receiveth the prize? So run, that ye may obtain." (1 Cor. 9:24) The prize is eternal life. "Let us run with patience the race that is set before us." (Heb. 12:1)

Christ after the Spirit

After Saul met Jesus Christ on the road to Damascus, he became a follower of "Christ after the Spirit." Do you even know who this "Christ after the Spirit" is?
