MESSAGE 3 - 2007

"HE THAT SHALL ENDURE UNTO THE END, THE SAME SHALL BE SAVED!"

"But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved...but the end is not yet." (Matt. 24:13,6)

The Bible plainly tells us, "but the end is not yet." Luke the physician, reiterates the declaration, "Take heed that ye be not deceived: for many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ (Christ is the head of the church. The false prophets are saying "I am Christ" by virtue of these three name non-profit religious incorporations whereby the law declares the pastor to be the president.); and the time draweth near: go ye not therefore after them. But when ye shall hear of wars and commotions, be not terrified: for these things must first come to pass; BUT THE END IS NOT BY AND BY." (Lk. 21:8-9) Luke confirms the prophecies of Matthew 24, "but the end is not yet." It is coming, but has not arrived as of this date.

Ever since I was a young man of 21, classified 1A by the local draft board, I've heard of wars and rumors of wars. This sixth verse of the 24th chapter of Matthew's gospel is simply stating that this is a period of history we will all go through, BUT THE END IS NOT YET! 
Did the bridegroom tarry?

Please note, the 24th chapter of Matthew begins by saying, "And Jesus went out." It is quite obvious the translators inserted the "Chapter 24" in the middle of a thought. Matthew 24 should have been inserted at the commencement of telling us where Jesus "went out" from, which is told to us in Matthew 23:37-39. These scriptures should be included in the reading of Matthew 24.

"Jesus wept" (Jn. 11:35) over Lazarus who was dead in his tomb. Jesus probably wept many tears over Jerusalem, as well as over you and me as our High Priest. But the Son of God is through weeping,

and now brings judgment upon Jerusalem. "Behold, your house is left unto you desolate." (Matt. 23:38) It was following this judgment in Jerusalem that the 24th chapter begins. "And Jesus went out, and departed from the temple: and his disciples came to him for to shew him the buildings of the temple." (Matt. 24:1)

Unbeknownst to His disciples, Jesus had already pronounced judgment on the temple in Jerusalem. Yet they came to him enthralled with the brick and mortar of the temple, "for to shew him the buildings." "See ye not all these things? verily I say unto you, There shall not be left here one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down." (Matt. 24:2) I wouldn't own a Bible that didn't have these "verily's" in it. How else would you know the conclusion of the subject in question? The "verily's" are what differentiates the Bible from a novel. "This is truth! The verdict is in! Next question, please."

Dallas Theological Seminary, founded by Dr. C.I. Scofield, must have awesome structures of concrete as well. For the students that graduate from this school are no different than the disciples who were so taken in by the sight of huge buildings making up the temple grounds in Jerusalem.
